

Visa to study in Spain

Students who live in a country within the European Union do not need to obtain a student visa for Spanish courses.

The visa is also not necessary if you want to take a course of less than 90 days (12 weeks) for students from the following countries:

ALBANIA, ANDORRA, OLD YUGOSLAV REPUBLIC OF MACEDONIA, ANTIGUA AND BARBUDA, ARGENTINA, AUSTRALIA, BAHAMAS, BARBADOS, BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA, BRAZIL, BRUNEI, CANADA, SOUTH KOREA, COSTA RICA, CHILE, EL SALVADOR, UNITED STATES, GUATEMALA, HONDURAS , ISRAEL, JAPAN, MALAYSIA, MAURITIUS, MEXICO, MONACO, MONTENEGRO, NICARAGUA, NEW ZEALAND, PANAMA, PARAGUAY, SAN CRISTÓBAL AND NIEVES, SAN MARINO, SANTA SEDE, SERBIA, SEYCHELLES, SINGAPORE, URUGUAY, VENEZUELA.

If you do not have a passport from any of the countries mentioned above and your Spanish course lasts more than 90 days, please read the following tips carefully.

1. Check with your local Spanish embassy or consulate, preferably 120 days before you leave (at least 60 days before) about the requirements to obtain the student visa.
2. Register at ELE USAL MALLORCA indicating your nationality and the specific requirements to obtain your visa (if there are any), [to guarantee the visa your local embassy will ask you to contact ELE USAL MALLORCA to confirm that the price of your course and of your accommodation have been paid in full].
3. The Spanish school ELE USAL MALLORCA will send you the Certificate of Enrollment (the letter of invitation to study) by express mail (FedEx or DHL) during the same day (plus a copy by e-mail immediately). Certificate of registration - your "letter of invitation to study"

It is an indispensable requirement for the local Spanish embassy or consulate before giving you a study visa for Spain. This document proves that you have enrolled in a Spanish course and must state your name, the details of the course and accommodation, the dates of the course and the confirmation that the course **and**

accommodation have been paid in full. It must be signed by the director of ELE USAL MALLORCA and with the official seal of the school.

The form for the study visa in Spain.

Complete your form to request the student visa. Attach all documents including the Certificate of Registration of ELE USAL MALLORCA. Some countries allow the petition process to start with a faxed copy.

However, keep in mind that, although at the language school ELE USAL MALLORCA we are delighted to assist you in the process of obtaining the visa, we must work within the margins set by your local Spanish embassy. It is there where they make all the decisions regarding the granting of this visa and have the final word, that is, they make their final decision.

In the event that the request is rejected or rejected after paying all fees for the course and accommodation, ELE USAL MALLORCA undertakes to refund the amount paid in full, less administrative charges. Administrative charges amount to € 150. In any case, if you obtain a successful visa and study a course at the school, administrative charges are dispensed with.

The frequent requirements to obtain the student visa for Spain.

- Passport valid at least 120 days before expiring.
- The completed Visa petition form.
- Certificate of Registration.
- Accreditation of economic resources (documentation that proves that you have sufficient financial resources to stay in Spain).
- A private insurance policy - ELE USAL MALLORCA can advise a health insurer if you wish.

- Confirmation of the details of your accommodation while you are in Spain
- The confirmation of ELE USAL MALLORCA that the course and the accommodation have been paid in full.

Answers to some questions about the visa to study in Spain

Who is considered a student?

Foreigners who come to Spain with the sole purpose of studying or carrying out an investigation, practice or any other non-profit activity in an official and recognized Spanish centre (educational, scientific, public or private).

Who needs a visa to study in Spain?

Foreign students who want to continue their studies in Spain must ask for the corresponding visa in the diplomatic offices or in the consulate, before their arrival. The tests of previous studies in the country will also be delivered. Students who do not need a visa for a stay of more than 90 days, do not need it unless their period in Spain exceeds that time.

How long is the visa?

It is guaranteed throughout the duration of the Spanish course at ELE USAL MALLORCA

Is the visa renewable?

Yes, your visa to study in Spain is renewable.

When does the visa expire?

- When the activity for which it was conceived reaches its end.
- When the period for which it is useful ends.

Can relatives of foreign students come?

Students who have obtained a visa to study in Spain can request the corresponding visas for their relatives to enter and be in Spain for the duration of the course (the studies) or the corresponding investigation.
